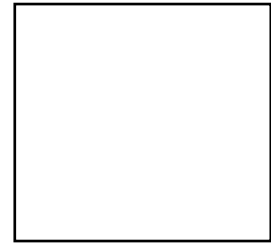

REQUIREMENTS IN RESPECT OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANT (ARCHITECTURE)
MEMBERSHIP REGISTRATION

1. Copies of the following Certificates/Documents should be attached to this application:
 - (a) Ordinary Level Certificate or its equivalent
 - (b) Trade School Certificate from a government trade centre or any accredited institution
 - (c) Affidavit in support of discrepancies in Names (if applicable)

Note: That NIA insists on candidates possessing the minimum requirements for studying Architecture as follows:

Three (3) credits in G.C.E. "O" Level or its equivalent at one sitting or four credits (4) at two sittings, including a pass in mathematics and technical drawing.
2. All copies of credentials to be submitted by applicants must have "Original seen by me" duly signed and dated, and ARCON seal affixed, with name of the signatory (who must be a current financial Council Member) after sighting the originals.
3. Originals of Certificates should be produced on request.
4. Referees must be full financial members of the Institute and at least one referee must have been a member of not less than 5 years standing and ethically liable for any false information contained herein. While the second referee must have been a member of not less than 3 years' standing.
5. Applicants should ensure that their referees are current financial members of the NIA.
6. It is the duty of the applicant to find out from his referees whether or not they are current financial members of the Institute.
7. The NIA will not be prepared to supply applicants with names of members who are current financial members of the Institute.
8. In the event of any of the two referees not being current financial member of the Institute, the application forms of the applicant would be rejected and the applicant would be required to purchase new application forms from the NIA Secretariat.
9. Two copies of the applicants passport photograph duly endorsed and sighted by one of the Referees as follows:

date and signature are required.
